NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the amendment of the New Mexico Judicial Branch Personnel Rules Part I for Employees and Part II for At-Will Employees are APPROVED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above-referenced amendments shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* as of **July 1, 2025**.
