




1 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED the Rural Justice Initiative law clerks  
2 are exempted from Supreme Court Order No. S-1-AO-2024-00012, *In the Matter of*  
3 *the Approval of a Reclassification Initiative for Attorneys, Appellate Legal Editors,*  
4 *Paralegals, and Law Clerks Employed Within the New Mexico Judicial Branch for*  
5 *Fiscal Year 2024; and*

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the compensation authorized by this order  
7 for Rural Justice Initiative law clerks employed by the New Mexico Judicial Branch  
8 is fixed at \$75,000 per year, in addition to all judicial branch benefits, and shall be  
9 effective immediately.
